

ASCENSION ISLAND GOVERNMENT

Guidance notes on support for post-16 education

- 1. The support will be paid to the parents of eligible young people commencing 1st May 2012.
- 2. Support will be provided for children educated in the UK/St Helena subject to the following criteria. Applications falling outside the criteria will considered in exceptional circumstances.
 - a. The student must be enrolled at Two Boats School at the time of making the application. For applications by children already in education in the UK (or on AIG's Youth Training Programme), the pupil must have been enrolled at Two Boats School prior to starting their programme of education.
 - b. The student must have completed one full year of their GCSE course at Two Boats School.
 - c. The student must be or must have been over 16 and under 19 years of age on 1st September in the year in which the support starts.
 - d. The proposed vocational or academic provision must be adjudged appropriate by the Post-16 Panel. (The Director of Resources (Chair), The Head Teacher, the Chair of the School Governors (or other member of the School Governors)
 - e. Applicants may be interviewed by the Director of Resources and the Head Teacher.
 - f. The scheme is only available to the children of Ascension Island taxpayers whose primary source of income is their employment on Ascension and who are resident on Ascension.
- 3. The financial support will be paid in three equal instalments each of £1,000 in September, January and May, and will be subject to the following criteria:
 - a. The grant is intended to fund two years of sixth form college
 - b. The grant may be used to meet actual expenditure incurred including flights, boarding accommodation and medical insurance.
 - c. The grant is subject to satisfactory performance in the educational provision.
 - d. If the student ends their education without completing a full academic year, the grant paid in respect of that academic year will be repayable.
