- ❖ Year 9 students are expected to do **at least 40 mins —1 hour** per subject/homework
- ❖ Year 10 students have **at least an hour+** per subject/homework
- ❖ Year 11 students are expected **at least an hour +** per subject/homework

In the event when students are unable to meet the homework deadline we will apply the following:

- Homework incomplete due to not understanding the task - they must ask for clarification before the due date and will have it further explained and being offered a **support session at lunch break** to complete this – failing to take advantage of this will result in a lunchtime detention
- Should they forget to bring in work according to the deadline set - they will be given the next day to hand in work – failing to meet this second request will result in a lunchtime detention
- Consistent lack of effort to meet homework requirements – an after school detention will be given; and if of a serious concern, parents will be invited in to discuss the way forward.

Monitoring homework:

- Class teachers will ensure that adequate time in lessons is given to record homework set
- Form tutors will check that homework diaries are kept in order at least once
- Homework diaries will be provided to record homework set and **we would like for parents to monitor the work set for homework tasks and ensure that they are signed before the start of the week.**
