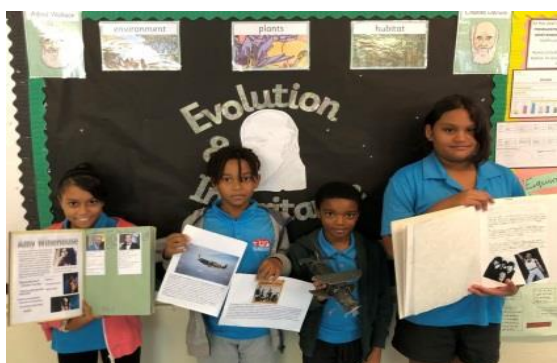
Easter Artwork

The children reflected on the Easter story and produced these powerful images.



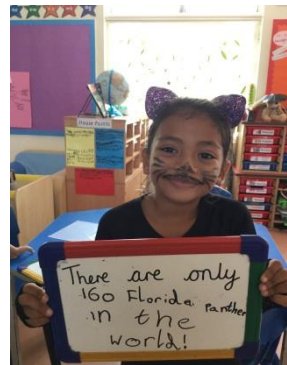
Year 5/6 - Easter Home Learning Projects
