Values and Attitudes

Children learn their values and attitudes from a wide range of sources. The most important of these is the home but the school has a vital part to play. At Two Boats School we aim to:

- 1. Develop a clear understanding of right and wrong.
- 2. Encourage pupils to develop responsibility and a positive sense of their own worth based on honesty, reliability, and self-discipline.
- 3. Encourage a caring attitude, a belief in equality of opportunity, a respect for the rights of others and a capacity for independent thought.
- 4. Develop the ability to work co-operatively whilst providing opportunities for healthy competition.
- 5. Encourage an active concern for the environment, locally and world wide.
- 6. Maintain a disciplined and friendly atmosphere within which everyone in the school treats each other with courtesy, respect and tolerance.

Teaching and Learning

We believe that every child has the capacity to learn and has something positive to offer society, so we aim to:-

- 7. Provide a broad, balanced curriculum that pupils find stimulating and enjoyable, and that provides them with skills, knowledge and understanding relevant to their current and future needs.
- 8. promote the spiritual, moral social, cultural, intellectual and physical development of all pupils.
- 9. Encourage the pursuit of excellence by developing the talents and abilities of each pupil to the full.
- 10. Provide for the special needs of all pupils including those with particular abilities or disabilities.
- 11. Promote physical fitness and healthy living.

Community Education

We believe that learning takes place both inside and outside the school and that learning is a lifelong process, we aim to:-

- 12. Encourage pupils to play a full part in the life of the school and the community.
- 13. Offer opportunities for education and leisure to all members of the community.
- 14. Promote full community use of the school site and facilities.
- 15. Maintain a pleasant, healthy and safe working environment.

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Partnerships

We believe that we have many partners in educating the children of our community so we aim to:-

- 16. Work in close co-operation with parents, keeping them fully informed on the progress of their children and the life of the school, and being prepared to discuss all issues with them.
- 17. Recognize the responsibility of the class teacher and the form tutor to provide continuity and stability for pupils in the school.
- 18. Establish and maintain close links with the local business community including local employers.

- 19. Work together as an effective team within which each member is recognised and valued.
- 20. Involve all staff in the decision making processes of the school.
