Our topic focus is 'The Romans,' and we have already produced some awesome home topic projects, such as Roman shields and Roman artwork (thanks to parents for your super support!)



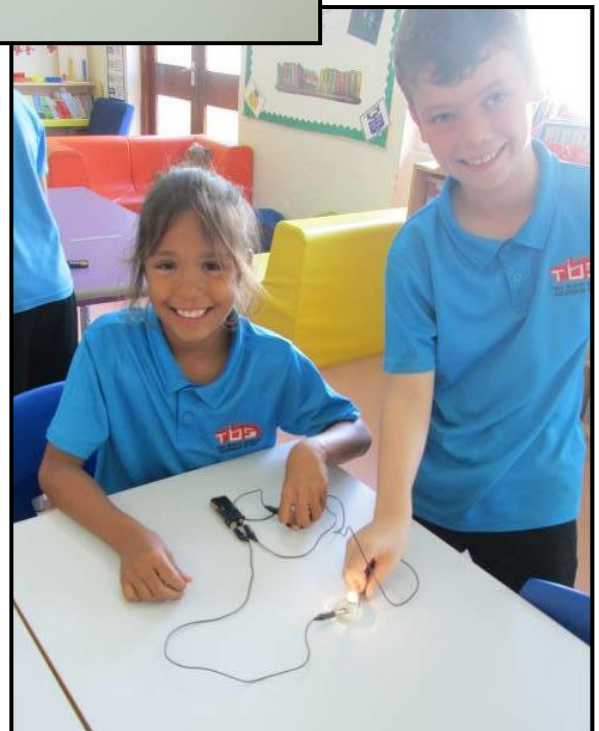
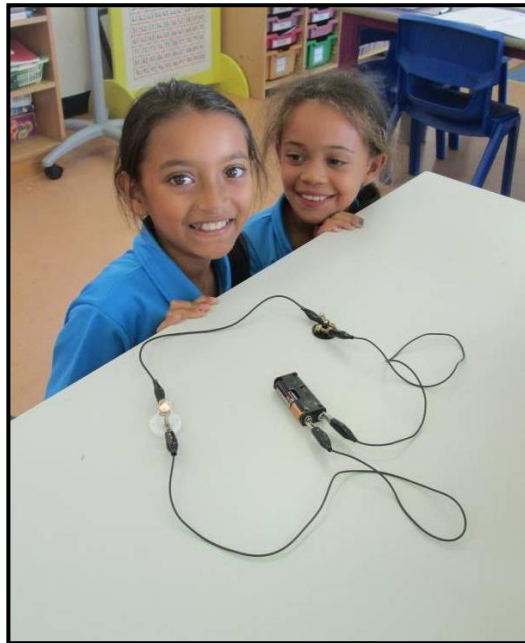
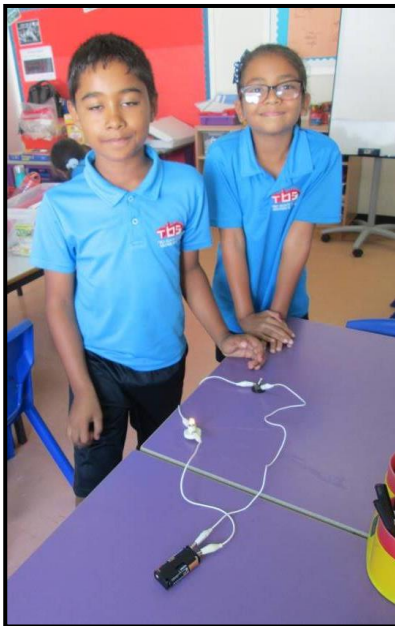
