In Maths we have learnt so much this year. We are recapping and consolidating all our knowledge so we're ready for our next year aroup in September.

















In French class, year 1 and 2 have got into the spirit of Euro 2020 and created their own designs for a football kit. They used their knowledge of the colours in French to label their work.










