## World Teacher Appreciation Day:



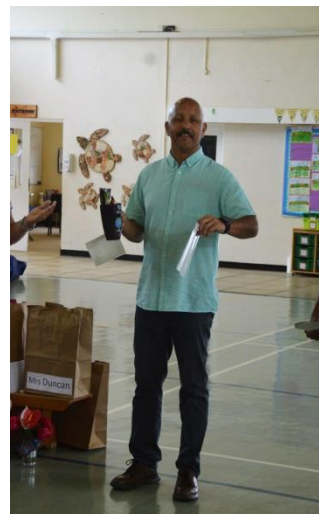
