Year 10/11 visit to Encompass

As a part of our IGCSE Physics, Year 10/11 has been studying electromagnetism. In lessons students have been learning about electromagnetic effects and their application in DC motors, AC generators and transformers.



To put some of this learning into context we visited the Power station at Encompass. The morning started in the classroom with a lesson delivered by Rick and Steve on how the Power station works and the roles of the generators, motors and transformers. This was an excellent way to kick start the visit. The students then had time to ask Rick and Steve questions they had prepared.

We then went to the Power Station and were shown around the Control Room, the engine hall and had a look at the RO plant. It was an amazing tour and the students and I would like to thank Rick. Steve and their staff who work hard to ensure we have all the electricity and water we need at the flick of a switch or the turn off a tap.

The students were asked to sum up the visit in one word and to give something they took away:

Educational – It was great seeing how motors are used in the real world.

Loud & Noisy — With 2 engines running a total of 800KV was being generated. This was enough to feed the Island at that particular time, with no back up needed from the wind turbines.

Enjoyable – I was fascinated with the engine hall and found out about the role of the fire wire.

Interesting — I was amazed at the number of roles carried out at Encompass

Knowledgeable – I found out that there are 5 working engines and 5 wind turbines (although 2 are broken and need repairing)

Informative – The cost of 1 unit of electricity is 61.27p and a litre of water 3.29p.

Factual – The excess salt from the water making process gets pumped back into the sea.
