










In French lessons this past half term, year 1 and 2 have been looking at the calendar. They've learnt how to say the days of the week and the months of the year. They then incorporated their prior learning of numbers and were then able to say their birthdays. The students have made some lovely display pieces, showing that they can write their dates of birth and they showed excellent teamwork by putting the days and months in order.



In Geography we have been looking at animals around the world. We have learnt about the equator line and how the Earth's temperature and climate changes in relation to the distance from it. We have explored how animals features are suited to where they live, the diet they eat and the type of animal they are, as well as looking at the five main requirements that enable animals (including humans) to thrive and grow.

We worked in groups to create the various habits below and created labels to show the food source, water source, area to protect the young and provided shelter.
