We all decorated crowns with sparkly sequins and jewels. There were lots to eat and we did some dancing!





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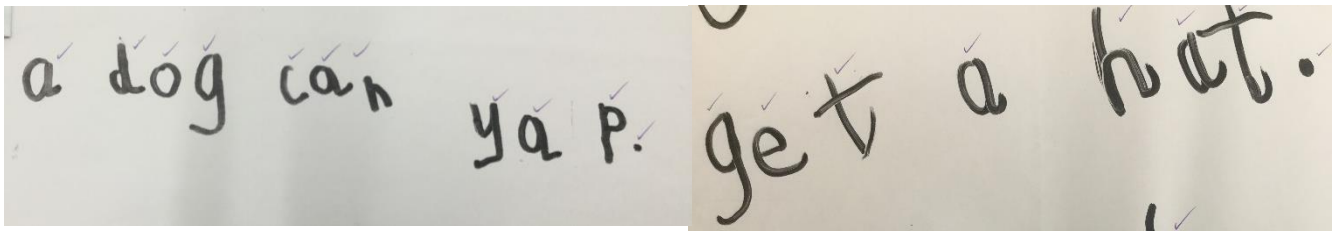
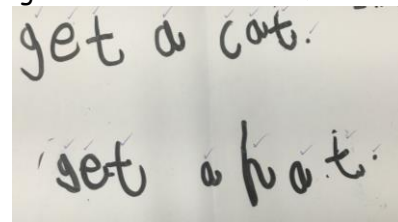


