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#### Hello from Year 5 &6

This term our focus in science has been about space. We had lots of questions about how the solar system works and our place within



oegan by finding out old ideas of how the solar system worked and then began

to explore how these changed over time due to different scientific discoveries and new thinking. We found out about the different planets, their order in distance away from the sun and how this affects their climate. We explored the connections between the Earth's orbit of the sun and its rotation and that of our seasonal year and night and day.

Much of our learning involved practical demonstrations at Earth level! These included; creating the solar system in the playground, modelling night and day using a wheely chair and a torch, and learning about the phases of the moon using Jaffa cakes or Oreo cookies! (our favourite bit!)

As part of our Cooking Design technology curriculum this term we have been exploring sweet and savoury recipes. We also learned about the research, design, plan, create and evaluative process involved in making a product. This term we made our own burgers.



We first of all recapped what we knew about food hygiene and safety BEFORE we went into the kitchen. We then designed our own burgers, thinking about not only what tasted good, but also




