Swimming

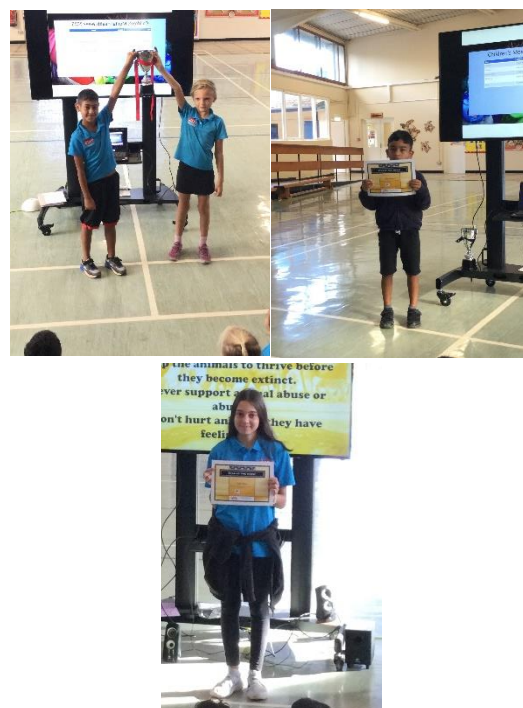
Swimming lessons for Years 3 – 11 will not start this week as hoped as Mr Duncan is still in the UK. We are

We began the New Year learning about what the New Year entails and how people like to make new year's resolutions. We created New Year Collage's to display in our classroom.

Our topic this term
