Term 3 has gotten off to a very busy start here at TBS!

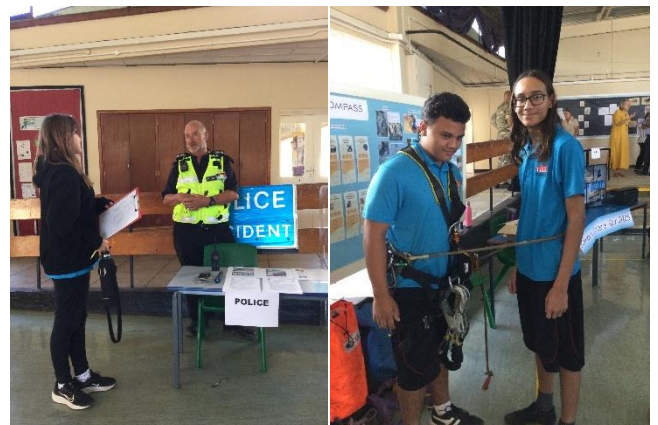
